



How can you control **RS422** PTZs through a matrix controller as well as a DVR? All you need is the CM9760-DMR, Data Manager. The CM9760-DMR allows four devices to communicate to one data port. In this example, the "port" is the CM9760-CDU-T. Up to Sixteen PTZs can be connected to one CM9760-CDU-T.

Instead of the CM6800, or in addition to it, a CM6700, CM9740, CM9760 or even a KBD300A could be plugged into the CM9760-DMR. Security managers can control the domes remotely via the DX8000 without interfering with the day-to-day operations of the guard staff controlling the PTZs. A conflict will arise, however, if both parties try to control the same PTZ at the same time.
